## THE BOTANICAL GARDEN AS HEADQUARTER

The main place for the celebration of the congress is the Botanical Garden of the University of Valencia from 20<sup>th</sup> until 24<sup>th</sup> in June. This historical place, which collects over 4500 plants species from around the world and locates monumental trees which are up to 180 years old, was founded in 1567 as a garden of medicinal plants. Nowadays it is a research and dissemination centre for plant diversity allowing the preservation of endemic or threatened species of Valencia flora and it is a reference place for holding conferences as the current 16<sup>th</sup> ISELV.

#### Monday 20th


#### Tuesday 21st-Friday 24th

The scientific sessions will be celebrated from 21st unit the 24th June in the "Joan Plaça" Auditorium (4). During these days, the access to the Botanical Garden will be by the secondary entrance from the Beato Gaspar Bono, 6, street (just in the corner of the building) (3). All the acts and scientific sessions will be transmitted online and posters will be uploaded to a virtual platform as well. Because we would like that all people registered have access to all the acts, we encourage all posters' authors to send to the organising committee a digital copy of their poster to be uploaded in a private area of our webpage to be distributed amongst the online delegates.

In the general programme you can see the specific sessions, talks, keynotes and additional social events. In these sense, a social drinks event will take place on Tuesday 21st at the terrace of the "Estufa Freda" (7) at 18:00 and for the Wednesday 22nd we have prepared a guided tour to Valencia's old town at 19:00h. The conference dinner will take place in the "Masía Santa Rita" restaurant on Friday 24th at 20:30h. This restaurant is located at the Albufera's Natural Park, so a bus will pick us up at 19:00 at the main entrance of the Botanical Garden (St. Quart, 80). Please, be punctual because the restaurant is away from the City and it is complicated to get in by public transport. The event will include a boat ride on the lake and a post dinner disco party until 4 am. At the end of the dinner, a coach will be coming back to the botanical gardens every 1-1.30h, so you can return to the city at your desired time.

### Saturday 25th-Wednesday 30th

During these days the **post-conference field trip** will take place. The organising committee of the field trip will contact the attendees with relevant information.

### POSTER PRESENTATIONS

All scientific **posters** will be exposed in the virtual platform during the celebration of the congress, so they must be sent in the specified format. Deadline to send the posters is 17<sup>th</sup> June. The **posters** of the in-person attendess will be **exposed at the Botanical Garden in the "Hort de Tramoires" hall**. Holders for the exposition will be provided by the Organising Committee.

The **SIZE** for all posters (both in-person and virtual modality) is **A0** (841 mm width x 1189 mm long) in **VERTICAL FORMAT.** 

It is **mandatory to send the poster to** the email address **iselv2022@uv.es** in **PDF format** before the deadline above commented.

We have created a small session for virtual posters on the 23<sup>rd</sup> from 17:30 until 18:00. Authors that contribute to the congress with a virtual poster could expose their work in this session (5-10 min defense is recommended). In addition, virtual delegates will be able to make questions to the poster's authors that attend in-person in this session. For this last reason, it is important (if not mandatory) that people with a poster contribution attend this session.

## ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Oral contributions will take place in the "Joan Plaça" Auditorium. In the general programme attached, you can check the timing of each contribution.

The length for general talks is 15 minutes plus 5 minutes for questions, while for keynotes is 30 minutes plus 10 minutes for questions. The Invited talks will have 45 minutes, plus 10 minutes for questions, preceded by a 10-15 min presentation of our honoured speakers. The time for presentations is the same both in-person and virtual modality. Please, try to get in time to the facility for a timely development of the schedule.

We recommend you give a copy of your presentation to the organisation team before the beginning of each session, in order to ease the development of scientific session. The organisation will provide all technical equipment (laptop with W10, laser pointer and microphone). We advise you to bring your presentation in different formats (ppts and pdf) in order to avoid possible technical problems related with the different software versions.

Questions by the virtual participants will be made through the chat available on the virtual platform and they will be read in the question time for each presentation.











## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR VIRTUAL MODALITY

The virtual platform for oral presentations is Blackboard Collaborate. This platform doesn't require to be downloaded, and a link to the different sessions will be send before the beginning of the congress.

Authors attending online MUST record their talks keeping the times specified and send them IN ADVACE to iselv2022@uv.es. This is important to avoid possible issues derived from a bad internet connection that might prevent the correct progress of the congress. The Deadline for sending the records is 19<sup>th</sup> June.

On the 20<sup>th</sup> June, a small session with all the online participants will take place, to check the stability of the internet connection, how to share your screen and give the last instructions. It is important that the online participants use the same computer that they will be using during the symposium.

Authors must connect before their session and wait for the chairman/organising committee to allow them access at the moment of their session. Please, let us know in advance if you prefer to make the presentation in vivo or using the recording uploaded to the virtual platform.

As stated in previous emails, we welcome any contributions related with the congress topic, but those contributions does not necessarily have to be presented during the congress. Our main goal is to compile a volume where all the early/lower vertebrate community is represented, thus, all your contributions are welcome.

The deadline for submitting your contributions will be 31st October, but if you have problems to complete your work before this date, please contact us in order to consider an extension. In any case, all papers received will be peer-reviewed and published online as they are accepted and edited. You must follow the "Guide for authors" provided by the journal at https://sepaleontologia.es/instructions-authors/. We expect to publish the physical volume during the spring-early summer of 2023.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR VIRTUAL MODALITY
